

TOUR CONDITIONS

AIR TRANSPORTATION/RULES - Round trip economy class jet airfare with Delta, Air France and Royal Jordanian airlines.

LUGGAGE - Allowed free of charge to your first overseas destination and from most points of return to the U.S.A., 1 bag per person plus a carry on – This may change by departure time..

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS - Hotels featured in this tour are semi deluxe, first class and kibbutz. All rooms are twin bedded with private bath and the tour price is based on two people sharing one room. Anyone occupying a room as a single will be charged a single supplement. The judgment pertaining to the classification of hotels reflects only the opinion of the tour operator as to comparative desirability.

TRANSFERS - Transportation of passengers and luggage is provided on arrival and departure from airports to and from hotels and is included in the tour cost when traveling with the main tour party.

SIGHTSEEING - As described in this brochure, via air-conditioned motor coach with English speaking, government licensed guides. Entrance fees per the itinerary are included.

MEALS - Breakfast and dinner daily, plus 2 lunches

DOCUMENTS - Each passenger must possess a valid passport. Non USA citizens may require additional visas. All passengers are responsible to obtain the correct travel documentation (passport, visa, identification) for the destination(s) to be visited. For USA citizens, visas to Egypt are \$35.00 and departure tax from Jordan is \$16 and will be arranged by Bound to Travel

INCLUDED - Hotel service charges and taxes levied by hotels and governments, tips for baggage porters at hotels and airports for the group as a whole.

NOT INCLUDED - Tips to drivers and guides, passport fees, and items of a personal nature, such as laundry, mineral water, beverages, food other than the main meal menu, passport fees, insurance.

DEPOSIT - A deposit of \$500.00 per person is due within 7 days of registration to confirm your reservation, plus a **Copy of Your Passport Valid Up To 6 Months past your date of return.**

FULL PAYMENT - Due 60 days before departure on January 6, 2018.

CREDIT CARDS - We do accept major credit cards, Visa, Master Card, and American Express, for all services. Credit card charges will only be processed upon submission of a completed Bound to Travel Credit Card Authorization form. Payment by check will receive a \$200 discount on the total trip cost.

CANCELLATIONS AND CANCELLATION FEES:

120-90 days prior to departure \$100.00

90 – 45 days prior to departure \$250.00

45 - 30 days prior to departure 30% of tour cost

29 -15 days prior to departure 50% of tour cost

14 days or less 100% of tour cost

Plus all penalties and cancellation fees for the airfare as imposed by the carrier.

RATES - All tour prices are quoted based on tariffs, rules and currency exchange rates effective as of June 14, 2017.

MINIMUM PARTICIPATION - Tour price is based on a minimum of 25 passengers traveling together. If the group size falls below this minimum, adjustment of the tour price may be necessary.

RESPONSIBILITY - Bound To Travel, Inc. (Travel Agency) is acting as a mere agent for SUPPLIERS (identified on the accompanying documents) in selling travel-related accepting services, or in accepting reservations or bookings for services that are not directly supplied by this Travel Agency (such as air and ground transportation, hotel accommodations, meals, tours, cruises, etc.). Bound To Travel, therefore, shall not be responsible for breach of contract, failure to comply with any laws such as the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), or any intentional or negligent actions or omissions on the part of such suppliers, which result in any loss, damage, delay, inconvenience or injury to travelers or travelers' companions or group members.

Unless the term "guaranteed" is specifically stated in writing on your tickets, invoice, or reservation itinerary, Bound To Travel does not guarantee any of such supplier's rates, bookings, reservations, connections, scheduling, or handling of baggage or other personal effects. Bound To Travel shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages, or losses caused to any traveler in connection with terrorist activities, social or labor unrest, mechanical or construction failures or difficulties, diseases, local laws, climatic conditions, abnormal conditions or developments, or any other actions, omissions, or conditions outside the travel agent's control.

RISKS, CANCELLATIONS AND TRAVEL INSURANCE - Traveler assumes complete and full responsibility for, and hereby releases Bound To Travel from any duty of checking and verifying any and all passport, visa, vaccination, or other entry requirements of each destination, and all safety and security conditions of such destinations, during the length of the proposed travel. It is the passenger's responsibility to have proper documentation. However, we specifically recommend that U. S. Citizens traveling out of the USA do so with a valid U.S. Passport.

Bound To Travel shall not be responsible for any injuries, losses or damages in connection with terrorist activities, social or labor unrest, mechanical or structural integrity of air, sea and ground transportation and accommodations, diseases, local laws, terrorist acts, bankruptcy or cessation of supplier or carrier services, climatic conditions, Acts of God, delays, changes or cancellation of travel due to weather conditions, hotel services, accidents or health related problems before or while in transit for (e.g. an accident on the way to a tour), during, and after a tour, or any other actions, omissions, or conditions outside of Bound To Travel's control.

Traveler's retention of tickets, reservations, or bookings after issuance shall constitute consent to the above and an agreement on his/her part to convey the contents hereto his/her travel companions or group members. It is the traveler's responsibility to protect his/her purchases, and **Travel Insurance is strongly recommended**. Traveler is advised to obtain appropriate insurance coverage against these risks; information is available through this Travel Agency regarding travel insurance.

By embarking upon his/her travel, the traveler voluntarily assumes all risks involved in such travel, whether expected or unexpected. Traveler is hereby warned of the above risks as well as possible travel industry bankruptcies and medical and climatic changes, and the possibility the traveler may be unable to travel as scheduled because of personal emergency.
